GSR In supersession of Ministry of Water Resources, Brahmaputra Board (Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Financial Adviser) Group 'A' Posts Recruitment Rules, 2013 published in Extraordinary Part-II-Section 3-Sub-section(i) of Gazette of India published on 24th January, 2014 under G.S.R. 55(E) dated 31st December, 2013 and in exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (b), (d) and (e) of sub-section (2) of section 28 of the Brahmaputra Board Act, 1980 (46 of 1980), the Central Government in the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Financial Adviser in Brahmaputra Board, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement. -
 - (i) These rules may be called the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation, Brahmaputra Board (Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Financial Adviser) Group 'A' Posts Recruitment Rules, 2015.
 - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application. - These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Number of posts, classification and pay band and grade pay or pay scale - The number of the said posts, their classification and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc. - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
5. Disqualification - No person –
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:
 - (c) Provided that the Central government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
6. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories or persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application. - These rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and pay band and grade pay - The number of the said post, their classification and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc. - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. Disqualification - No person –

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts;

Provided that the Central government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax. – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories or persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
